

PRIVACY POLICY

Overview

This Privacy Policy describes The Odyssey's ("The Odyssey," "We," "Our," or "Us") policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use the Services and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Services. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

By using the Service, You agree to Our Terms and Conditions and to Our collection of, use and disclosure practices, and any other activities as described in this Privacy Policy. If You do not agree and consent, then discontinue use of the Service.

If You have any questions about Our privacy practices, please contact Us through the methods outlined in the section entitled "Contact Us" below.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions.

The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **You** means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.
- **Company** (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to The Odyssey.
- **Affiliate** means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.
- **Account** means a unique account created for You to access Our Service or parts of Our Service.
- **Website** refers to The Odyssey, accessible from <https://www.theodyssey.network>

- **Service** refers to the Website, Forum, and all other features, content, and other services that We own, control, and make available through such online services.
- **Country** refers to: Florida, United States
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Service or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.
- **Third-party Social Media Service** refers to any website or any social network website through which a User can log in or create an account to use the Service.
- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- **Cookies** are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that website among its many uses.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.
- **Usage Data** refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data You Provide

While using Our Service, We may ask You to provide Us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify You, such as when You register an account, update Your profile, access Our content, engage in gameplay, make a purchase, engage in polls and surveys, other promotions, apply for a staff position or contact customer support. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

Contact Data - We collect your first and last name, e-mail address, postal address, phone number, and other similar contact data.

Credentials - We collect passwords, password hints, and similar security information for authentication and account access.

Demographic Data - We collect demographic information such as Your age, gender, language, and country.

Payment Data - We collect data necessary to process Your payment if You make a purchase, such as Your payment instrument number (such as a credit card number), and the security code associated with Your payment instrument.

Profile Data - We collect Your username, interests, favorites, and other profile data.

Player Data - We collect Your rank, player preferences, trophies found, clan membership, community memberships, friends and friend requests, players ignored, punishments, and advertisement participation.

Purchases - We collect all player purchases including time of purchase, item type, and quantity.

Polls and Votes - We collect Your answers to polls as well as any votes You make related to games or maps.

Contacts - We collect data about Your contacts in order to fulfill a request by You, such as finding Your contacts on the Service or inviting Your contacts to join the Service. Such functionality is only intended for United States residents. By using this functionality, You acknowledge and agree that both You and Your contacts are based in the United States and that You have Your contacts' consent for Us to use their contact information to fulfill Your request.

Content and Chat - We collect the content of messages You send to Us, such as feedback and product reviews You write, or questions and information You provide to customer support. We also collect the content of Your communications as necessary to provide You with the services You use. For example, if You chat with another user through the Service, We need to collect the content of that chat to display it to You and the other user as You direct.

Staff Application Data - We collect data as necessary to consider You for a job opening if You submit an application to Us, such as your employment history, transcript, writing samples, and references.

There maybe instances where You may choose voluntarily submit information that We do not request from You in the use of Our Services; therefore, in any such instance You are solely responsible for said information.

Automatic Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service as well as your gameplay.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, other diagnostic data, the products You purchase, and other similar information.

When You access the Service by or through a mobile device, We may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device You use, Your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of Your mobile device, Your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser You use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that Your browser sends whenever You visit our Service or when You access the Service by or through a mobile device.

We monitor, record, and collect Your in-game data including playtime, registration and login timestamps, player gameplay statistics, currencies, player owned kits and kit data, player preferences, login rewards and rewards streaks, owned, enabled, and selected cosmetics.

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on Our Service and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze Our Service.

You can instruct Your browser to refuse all Cookies or to indicate when a Cookie is being sent. However, if You do not accept Cookies, You may not be able to use some parts of our Service.

Cookies can be "Persistent" or "Session" Cookies. Persistent Cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when You go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as You close your web browser.

We use both session and persistent Cookies for the purposes set out below:

- **Necessary / Essential Cookies**

Type: Session Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with those services.

- **Cookies Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies identify if users have accepted the use of cookies on the Website.

- **Functionality Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These Cookies allow us to remember choices You make when You use the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these Cookies is to provide You with a more personal experience and to avoid You having to re-enter your preferences every time You use the Website.

Definitions of other tracking technologies that We use or may use in the future are as follows:

Log Files. A log file is a file that records events that occur in connection with Your use of the Service, such as Your service use data.

Web Beacon. A web beacon is code embedded in a website, video, e-mail, or advertisements that sends information about Your use to a server. There are various types of web beacons, including image pixels (which are small graphic images) and JavaScript pixels (which contains JavaScript code). When You access a website, video, e-mail, or advertisement that contains a web beacon, the web beacon may permit Us or a third party to drop or read cookies on Your browser. Web beacons are used in combination with cookies to track activity by a particular browser on a particular device. We may incorporate web beacons from third parties that allow Us track Our conversions, bring You advertising both on and off the Service, and provide You with additional functionality, such as the ability to connect Our Service with Your social media account.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain Our Service,** including to monitor the usage of Our Service in regards to Your registration and account, monitor and analyze trends, and activities.
- **To manage Your Account:** to manage Your registration as a user of the Service. The Personal Data You provide can give You access to different functionalities of the Service that are available to You as a registered user.
- **To perform services:** requested by You regarding responses to your comments, questions, and requests for providing customer service.
- **For the performance of a contract:** the development, compliance and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items or services You have purchased or of any other contract with Us through the Service.
- **To contact You:** To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.

- **To prevent** and respond to fraud, violation of policies or terms, and threats and harm.
- **To improve** the Service provided on Our websites, services, apps, products, and marketing services.

Sharing of Information

We may share Your personal information in the following situations:

- **With Service Providers:** We may share Your personal information with Service Providers to monitor and analyze the use of Our Service, to contact You.
- **For Business transfers:** We may share or transfer Your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of Our business to another company.
- **With Affiliates:** We may share Your information with Our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include Our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that We control or that are under common control with Us.
- **With Business partners:** We may share Your information with Our business partners to offer You certain products, services or promotions.
- **With other users:** when You share personal information or otherwise interact in the public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside. If You interact with other users or register through a Third-Party Social Media Service, Your contacts on the Third-Party Social Media Service may see Your name, profile, pictures and description of Your activity. Similarly, other users will be able to view descriptions of Your activity, communicate with You and view Your profile.
- **Third Parties:** We may share Your information with third parties for purposes of facilitating Your requests (such as when You choose to share information with a social network, such as Facebook or Twitter, about Your activities on the Service) and in connection with tailoring advertisements, measuring and improving Our Service and advertising effectiveness, and enabling other enhancements.
- **Security and Compelled Disclosure:** We may share Your information to comply with the law or other legal process, and where required, in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements. We may also share Your information to protect the rights, property, life, health, security and safety of Us, the Service or any third party.
- **Consent:** We may also share Your information for any other reasons or purpose disclosed to You and with Your consent.

In Our sole discretion, We may share accumulated data and information which does not identify You with third parties or affiliates for any purpose except as prohibited by applicable law. For more information regarding Your rights and choices in how We share Your information, please see the section entitled “Your Rights and Choices” below.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal

obligations (for example, if We are required to retain Your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce Our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of Our Service, or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Public Information

Certain areas of the Service, such as user profiles, forums, posts, comments, and blogs, are designed to help You share information with the world. If You make information public through Our Service, other people will have access to it. It is Your sole responsibility to think carefully about what information you make available for public consumption. Once You have posted information, You may not have the ability to edit or delete such information or prevent its dissemination; however, California residents have additional rights as set forth in “Your Rights and Choices” below.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

- Protect against legal liability

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of Your Personal Data is important to Us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While We strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect Your Personal Data, We cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Third Parties

We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third party sites or services.

Location-Identifying Technologies: The location data collected through an app depends on Your device settings and app permissions. You can exercise choice over the location data collected through Our apps by (a) for GPS data, disabling location in Your device settings or disabling location permissions to that app; (b) for Bluetooth data, disabling Bluetooth and any Bluetooth scanning option in Your device settings; or (c) for WiFi data, disabling WiFi and any WiFi scanning option in Your device settings. You can stop collection of all location data via an app by simply uninstalling the app.
